



Choreographers: Judy McDonald & John Robinson

Music: You Belong to Me
Jennifer Lopez ("This Is Me...Then" CD)

This is a **32 count 2-wall line dance**, with a 30 count intro...start with the lyrics on count 7 of the 4th set of 8 counts.

- 7&8& **R side, L back, R side, L cross**
Step R to side (7), step L behind right (&), step R to side (8), step L across in front of right (&)
- 1 2 3&4 **R side, sway, R ball cross**
Step R to side (1), sway L switching weight to left foot (2,3), step R back (&), step L across in front of right (4)
- 5 6 7 **R side, L rock, R step**
Step R to side (5), step L forward (6), step R in place (7)
- 8&1 2 3 **L cha with ¼ turn, R step, sway**
Step L to side (8), step R beside left (&), step L to side making ¼ turn left (1), step R forward (2), sway switching weight to left foot (3)
- 4&5 6 7 **R cha, L rock, R step**
Step R forward (4), step L beside right (&), step R forward (5), step L forward (6), step R in place (7)
- 8&1 2 **¼ turn L cha, hold**
Make ¼ turn L step side (8), step R beside left (&), step L to side (1), hold (2)
- &3 4 **R step, L step, R touch**
Step R beside left (&), step L to side (3), touch R beside left (4)
- 5 6 7&8 **Walk R, L, R triple (west coast sugar push)**
Step R forward (5), step L forward (6), step R behind left (7), step L in place (&), step R in place (8)
- 1 2 3&4 **L long step back, R drag, R ball change**
Push off right making long step back with L (1), drag R back (2,3), step R beside left (&), step L forward (4)
- 5 6 **Walk R, L**
Step R forward (5), step L forward (6)

Super easy 2-count tag...*beginning the 8th repetition (facing the back)...add an extra 2 count sway on counts 1, 2. There is a musical interlude just before this happens so you'll know it's coming! The count will be 7&8& 1 2 1 2 3&4.*

**The dance will finish facing front...end with the long step back on count 1 of the last set of 8.*

Tidbit of Info:

John & I choreographed this dance on Monday, August 11, 2003, in the parking lot of the Adam's Mark Hotel in Independence, Missouri, after the Dancin' Up a Storm event, using the CD player in his car....so, we do know for a fact that on a slight incline, the dance travels one parking space! ☺
